Agenda Items:

- 1. Powell-Division Transit and Development Project—Bob Stacey introduced the PDTDP with purpose to study transit corridors, amenities, modes of transit. Dana Lucero further explained this was to gage expectations and help align needs with demands on the transportation infrastructure in SE Portland. Finally Alexandra Howard discussed timing, grants and scope of project. It will be from the waterfront out to Mt Hood Community College. Goal is to bring better public transit to this part of Portland. There was a question and answer session after their presentation. There will be further open houses and meeting throughout the fall and winter throughout the community.
